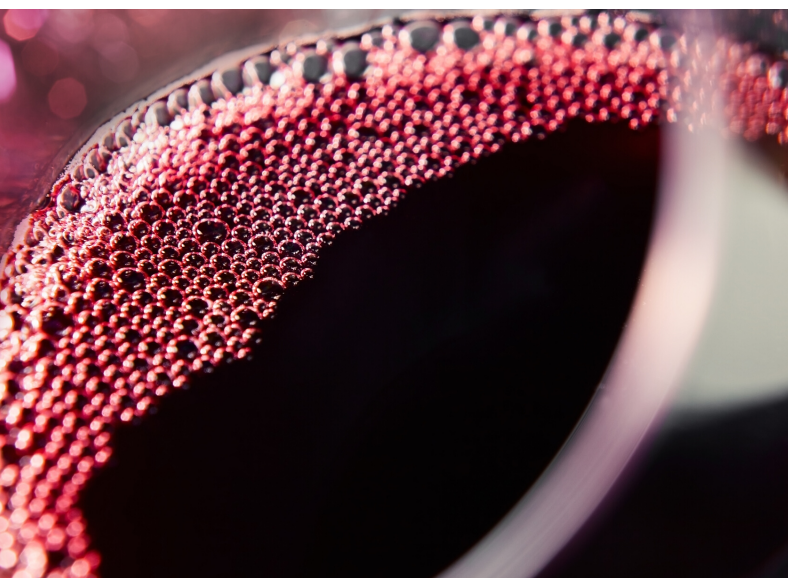


THE VINTAGE
